



## SFPA Safety Protocols

- 1) Follow all regulations and requirements of the sponsor bar, the City and County of San Francisco Health Department and the State of California at time of play.
- 2) Players are **required to wear masks at all times** during matches. Players who approach the table to shoot without a mask covering their mouth and nose will incur an immediate loss for that game. Masks are required regardless of vaccination status and/or current negative test.
- 3) Wash your hands frequently and always before and after a game.
- 4) Home team is required to sanitize all surfaces that will be used by teams.  
**These areas are listed, but not limited to:**
  - a) Billiard table surfaces, cue sticks provided by establishment and tables & chairs that are to be used by team members.
  - b) Visiting team can decide where they would like to locate their players and are required to cleanse that area.
  - c) Que ball must be sanitized after being touched by any player ie: ball in hand.
- 5) Players/Captains should provide their own sanitation items (hand sanitizers, wipes).
- 6) Players must adhere to social distancing requirements.
  - a.) Teams are encouraged to remain in their team bubbles at 6 ft distance (approximately a cue stick length away) – The Bubble Rule.
  - b.) No handshakes - verbal acknowledgment is acceptable.
- 7) Stay home if you are ill.
- 8) At end of play, home teams are required to disinfect all equipment provided by establishment.
