



SFPA Safety Protocols

Follow all regulations by the State of California Health Board, The City and County of San Francisco Health Department and any requirements of the sponsor bar at time of play.

Some bars may require proof of vaccination. Please be ready to provide both proof of vaccination and your ID (if needed) before gaining entry to the bar.

NON-VACCINATED PLAYERS

1. Non-vaccinated players are required to wear masks at all times during matches.
 - A.) Players playing a game, who approach the table to shoot without a mask covering their mouth and nose will incur an immediate loss, not a forfeit, for that game.
 - B.) If any other player(s) approach the table without a mask it will result in an immediate loss, not a forfeit, for that game. This includes time outs or any other reason(s).
2. Wash your hands frequently and always before and after a game.
3. Stay home if you are ill.

VACCINATED PLAYERS

1. Vaccinated players are also required to wear masks during matches.
 - A.) Players playing a game, who approach the table to shoot without a mask covering their mouth and nose will incur an immediate loss, not a forfeit, for that game.
 - B.) If any other player(s) approach the table without a mask it will result in an immediate loss, not a forfeit, for that game. This includes time outs or any other reason(s).
2. Wash your hands frequently and always before and after a game.
3. Stay at home if you are ill.

A warning should be given to players before defaulting to a loss. We want to protect our players but still show "Unity in Sportsmanship" amongst ourselves.
